The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Nos. / Drivers: 69 / Thierry Vermeulen and 99 / Lorenzo Patrese

Competitors: Emil Frey Racing and Tresor Attempto Racing

Time (fact): 16:10 hrs

Session: Race 2

Fact: Cars 69 and 99 collided at Turn 5

Regulation:: Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code


Decision: **No further action**

Reason: Cars 69 and 99 collided at turn 5, with car 69 leaving the track. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV and on-board video evidence, including from the following car, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
