IN CAR MARSHALLING SYSTEM

For the FCY and SC procedures the IN CAR MARSHALLING SYSTEM has priority on the flags

On screen general info:

YELLOW FLAGS /sector - RED - FCY (10 sec countdown) — SC — GREEN

On track Individual info: Warning flag, Blue Flag






























Speed 80 Km/Hr - NO weaving (Zig Zag)

FCY followed by SC except during the three 1st laps where it will directly SC

SC gets the leader during the FCY

Countdown 20 seconds – marshalling system

- At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
- At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
- RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 GREEN

OR































SC on track during the FCY (NO lights) It will overtake cars if necessary - No weaving "SC procedure"

- SC lights ON, all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap" "SC lights off" (all signalling removed)
- "Green" NO overtaking prior to pass the line



















PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC

Pit exit light remain GREEN

When the SC will pass the START LINE, the pit exit light will turn



When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn again



























RED FLAG PROCEDURE

Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking – drive to pit lane

Clock will NOT stop (neither for qualifying nor for the race)

Race: - line up red line (start line) or follow the SC

- Order as when the red flag was declared

- Parc-Fermé conditions - on the grid teams and officials ONLY

- Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later



























BLUE FLAG

- At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.
- During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.
- During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.



















TRACK LIMITS PENALTIES

- 1. FP: drivers will be warned and stopped, if necessary, lap times can be cancelled.
- 2. Qualifying: On the third time the best lap time of the driver will be cancelled.
- 3. Race: 1st time warning on the timing monitors,

2nd time warning flag.

3rd time final warning on the radio, at the

4th time the stewards can impose a penalty.


















