The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 111 / Christian Klien & Dean MacDonald
Competitor: JP Motorsport
Time (fact): 16:37 hrs
Session: Pre-Qualifying
Fact: Car 111 stopped less than 50cm from the white line designating the start of the working area and a wheel was not placed flat on the ground behind the line
Offence: Breaches of Articles 36.2 and 38.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations
Decision: **Reprimand to the Competitor**
Reason: Car 111 stopped during Pre-Qualifying less than the minimum 50cm from the white line designating the start of the working area which is specified in Article 36.2 of the Sporting Regulations. Then a replaced wheel was not placed flat on the ground behind the line as required by Article 38.1. Having heard from the competitor's representative, the Stewards determine that these are breaches of the above regulations but noting that no competitive advantage was gained in Pre-Qualifying they impose only a Reprimand in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
