Fact:

It was reported that car 31 was released from its pit stop in an unsafe manner

Offence:

Alleged breach of Article 34.16 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS

Sporting Regulations

Decision:

No further action

Reason:

It was reported that car 31 was released from its pit stop in an unsafe manner in front of car 60. Having heard from the competitor's representative and having viewed CCTV and gantry camera footage, the Stewards note that car 31 was given the release signal when car 60 was still at a reasonable distance but the car did not gain momentum as quickly as might have been anticipated. They do not consider this to be an unsafe release and

therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
