

## 2024 MAIN CHANGES

1. General: Changes in Pre-Q, each driver must perform 8 timed laps. Penalties scale revised, single reconnaissance lap, wave-by 6 and 24 Hrs. only,
2. Sprint: qualifying reduced to 10 ', one set of tires, electric wheel guns authorized.
3. Race control radio: New voice on the RC radio with specific wording and warning

- «Attention to all teams » for track procedures; FCY, RF...
- « Information for the teams » for general information; start of session delayed...
- « Penalty information » for stewards’ decisions

4. Request forms: No incident reports anymore; Only request forms but not for blocking and not for blue flags.
5. Track Limits : - Up to six [6] cameras to control the infringements.

- automatic time penalty that must be performed at the beginning of the pit stop. Otherwise added to race time.

6. «Full Course Yellow »Waved yellow flags will be shown at 10 seconds, FCY boards and flags at 0 .
7. «Fast Lane Open » Up to Six minutes prior the green lights with a 1-minute warning signal if possible
8. Red flag: Causing Red Flag during Qualifying, fastest lap time so far deleted.
9. Bronze Light: Pink light rear of the car illuminated when the Bronze driver is behind the wheel

## START

Cars straight to the grid, no installation laps.
Start line offset: 111 m Pole position: LEFT Start line-up: Turn 12 to 14


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## ROLLING START FORMATION

Leading car slow to 50 KPH and enter pit lane - Exit last turn the pole man increases slowly the speed to 110 KPH

## FCY

Countdown on the IN CAR MARSHALLING SYSTEM, that has priority on the flags

- At 10 sec Yellow Flags \& lights - No overtaking
- At O sec Flags+ Boards \& all cars at 80 KPH - NO weaving [zig zag]
- In case of short FCY - RESTART on short notice - GREEN



## SAFETY CAR

- SC on track during the FCY [NO lights] gets the leader. It will overtake cars if necessary. No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking
- SC procedure - SC lights ON, All marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap" - "SC lights off" [all signalling removed]
- "Green" at the line only - NO overtaking prior to pass the line


## SAFETY CAR

1st Lap: Turn 14
Race at Pit Exit


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## PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC

- Pit exit light remain GREEN
- When the SC will pass the START LINE, the pit exit light will turn RED
- When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn GREEN again


## RED FLAG PROCEDURE

## PIT EXIT CLOSED

NO OVERTAKING - Slow down to 80 KPH - drive to pit lane
During Qualifying: best lap time so far of the responsible driver deleted
Clock will only stop during the Qualifying Sessions - RF lap times deleted
Race: line up at the red line [ start line] or follow the SC
Parc-Fermé conditions - on the grid teams and officials ONLY
Restart behind SC
If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later

## BLUE FLAG

- At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.
- During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.
- During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.


## TRACK LIMITS PENALTIES

FIA Track limits all around the track. Cameras at the exit of T2, T5, T7, T10, T12 and T15.
FP: drivers will be warned and stopped, if necessary, lap times can be deleted.
Pre-qualifying and Qualifying: every lap time will be deleted.
Race: 3 first time warning on the timing monitors,
$4^{\text {th }}$ time warning flag (on the monitors).
$5^{\text {th }}$ time final warning on the radio, At the
$6^{\text {th }}$ time, 30 seconds time penalty. Drive through after 12 infringements after 18 report to the stewards
