The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director and reviewed video evidences, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 48 -

**Competitor:** Winward Racing

**Time:** 15:24

**Session:**

**Fact:** Car released in an unsafe manner

**Offence:** Breach of Article 28.16 and 28.17 of the GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** Time Penalty of 5 seconds to be added to the elapsed race time

**Reason:** Car #48 was released in an unsafe manner when car #63 was in the fast lane.  
The Stewards agreed that car 48 was at fault in this incident and committed a breach of the regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
