## STEWARDS' DECISION

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the driver(s) and the competitor's representative(s), have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 34 - Henrique Chaves

**Competitor:** Walkenhorst Motorsport (Trinity Solutions GmbH)

**Time:** 17:53

**Session:** Race

**Fact:** Forced car 911 off track at T5

**Offence:** Breach of Article 27.4 of the GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code

**Decision:** Time Penalty of 10 seconds to be added to the elapsed race time

**Reason:** Car #34 forced car #911 out of the track at T5. Both cars were side by side and car #34 did not leave room enough to car #911, promoting a contact and that car #911 went to the gravel and lost positions.  
The Stewards agreed that car 34 was at fault in this incident and committed a breach of the regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
