The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director and reviewed video evidences, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 33 - Chris Lulham

Competitor: 2 Seas Motorsport

Time: 16:45

Session: Race

Fact: Caused a collision with car #59 at T17

Offence: Breach of Article 27.4 of the GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code

Decision: Time Penalty of 10 sec to be added to the elapsed race time + 1 BWP

Reason: Car #33 caused an avoidable collision with car #59 at T17.
The Stewards agreed that car #33 was at fault in this incident and committed a breach of the regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
