The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 991 - Dries Vanthoor

Competitor: Paradine Competition

Time: 16:32

Session: Free Practice 2

Fact: car #991 weaved in the Pit Lane

Offence: Breach of Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2e) of Appendix L to the Code

Decision: 500€ Fine, suspended for the remainder of the 2026 GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS, subject to no further breach of similar nature during this period.

Reason: car #991 weaved in the pit lane. Driver Vanthoor admitted the fact and explained it was a joke with his former engineer, but assuming it as a mistake and apologising for the fact.
The Stewards agreed that this fact constitutes a breach of the regulations and decided to apply the above penalty.
