FANATEC GT WORLD CHALLENGE EUROPE POWERED BY AWS ENDURANCE CUP PRO-AM DRIVERS CLASSIFICATION

The Sporting Board has received a request from Sky Tempesta driver Christopher Froggatt, asking to be allowed to renounce the 6 points he scored in Monza in order to be on equal points with his full-season team-mate Jonathan Hui.

Considering that decisions on questions regarding the classification of the Series are within the missions of the Sporting Board, it is decided to accept this request on the following grounds:

- This request is considered to be in line with the spirit of the 2021 Sporting Regulations which state, in article 10.2, that the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Series is primarily intended for driver crews competing together throughout the season to claim the title.
- Jonathan Hui's absence from Monza was a case of force majeure due to Covid restrictions
- This request has the approval of the full-season teams competing in the Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS Endurance Cup Pro-Am category

The points renounced by Froggatt will not be redistributed, and remain acquired by the team and manufacturer, and any other drivers competing in that car in the race in question.

The renounced points will be disregarded in reference to article 7.9e) of the 2021 Sporting Regulations

The final classification of the Pro-Am category is therefore:

1st: Chris Froggatt / Jonathan Hui 95 2nd: Henrique Chaves / Miguel Ramos 78 3rd: Phil Keen / Hiroshi Hamaguchi 74
