

- > Agreement with ACI to race GTX within the Targa Florio in Sicily, using both the original numeration (106 editions as per today) and a portion of the original iconic roads establishing a link between the oldest sport car racing event in the world and the most modern race project in the 21st Century.
- > Targa Florio would be the perfect yearly racing prologue held in May, mixing exposure, efficiency, competition, scenic roads, and historical landmarks. Italian territory will naturally add glamour, elegance, fun & friendship, all elements that creates a juncture between modern racing cars and passion for the automotive field.


